RE: *Notice of Hearing under Virginia Code § 59.1-385(A) and 11VAC 10-45-60(A) — Churchill Downs, L.P., d/b/a/ Twinspires Advance Deposit Account Wagering License*

Issue: Starting July 1, 2015 and continuing to the present, Churchill Downs, L.P., d/b/a Twinspires failed to pay the Virginia Equine Alliance the 4% of revenue from advance deposit account wagering due to it as the recognized industry stakeholder organization, in violation of § 59.1-392.1(A)(iii)(1) of the Virginia Code.

The hearing to consider the above issue will be conducted by the Virginia Racing Commission on **November 17, 2015 at 10:00 a.m., in the Patrick Henry Building, 1111 East Broad Street, Richmond, Virginia 23219.**

Churchill Downs, L.P. may present evidence on its behalf and subpoena witnesses to testify for it. It may be represented by an attorney. Public data, documents, and information may also be considered by the Virginia Racing Commission.

Please make continuance requests as soon as you are aware of a conflict with the hearing date, and no later than five working days prior to the hearing. If a continuance request is made less than five working days before the hearing, extenuating circumstances that could not be foreseen must be shown.
